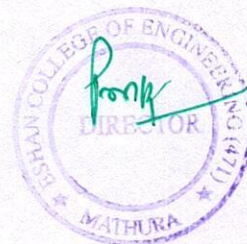

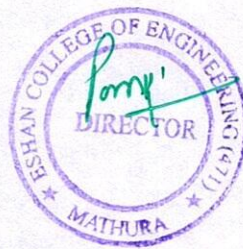



(Non-Visual Desktop Access)



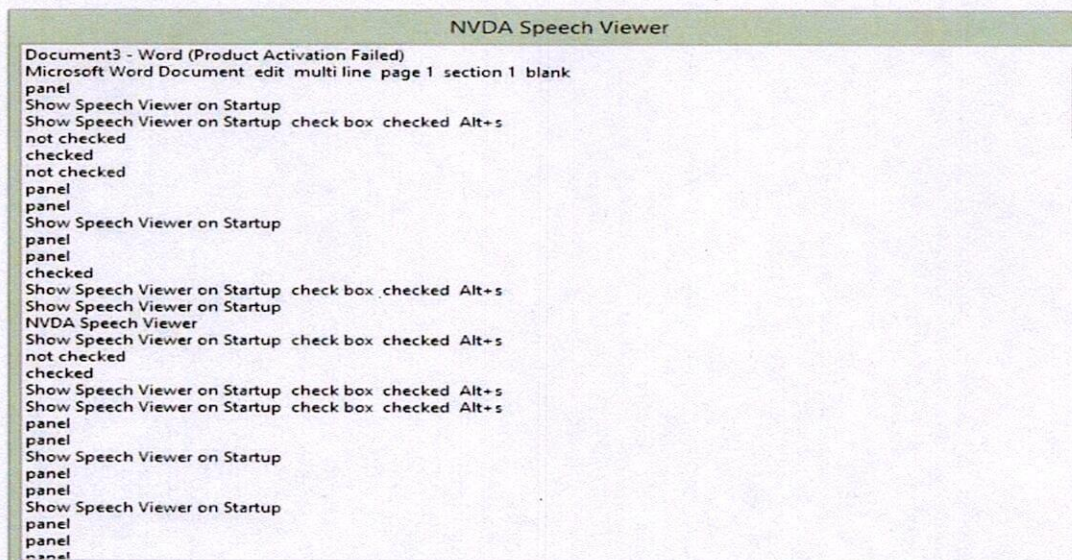
SCREEN READER

Name of the software: - NVDA (Non-Visual Desktop Access) for Windows Screen reader is an assistive software programme, which helps the visually impaired, or the blind to work with computer. The Non Visual Desktop Access (NVDA) is free; open-source software. It is installed in the computers at Central Library to help the visually challenged students in learning.
