Activity- "Covid Awareness Camp"

Scheme- Social Welfare

The evolving outbreak of coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) required social distancing and other measures to protect public health. However, messaging has been inconsistent and unclear. Many casual laborers--individuals who provide temporary, part-time work, often hired on an hourly or daily basis--are temporary migrant workers. These workers travel from their homes to the city for periods of time in search of work and their health was also in danger. In order to alert villagers about COVID-19 consequences, "**Covid Awareness Camp(Chopal Entrance near GT Road, Farah Village)**" was organized by Eshan Club, ECE to determine COVID-19 awareness, knowledge, attitudes, and related behaviours among adults who are more vulnerable to complications of infection because of age and comorbid conditions. The following points were highlighted-

- The infection could spread by- Air - by cough or sneeze, Personal contact, Contaminated objects, Surface transmission, Community spread, Droplets, person-to-person transmission and mass gathering.
- Symptoms may take up to 14 days to appear after exposure to COVID-19. This is the longest known incubation period for this disease.
- Virus can be transmitted to others from someone who is infected but not showing symptoms. This includes people who are: Pre-symptomatic: have not yet developed symptoms and Asymptomatic: never develop symptoms.

There were 20 participants who tried to explain some preventative measures so that the villagers would be able to protect themselves as well as their families in a simple yet effective manner such as-Avoid common greetings, such as handshakes, stay at home unless you have to go to work, avoid all non-essential trips, do not gather in groups, cover your mouth and nose with flexed elbow or tissue while coughing or sneezing and if you suspect you have COVID-19 symptoms, contact a medical professional immediately. Efforts were appreciated by our Chairman.
