Activity- "Stationery Distribution to Needy Kids drive"

In order to help street children, kick-start their educational journeys and write brighter futures for themselves, Eshan Club decided to aid them in a distinctive way by distributing stationery under the activity "**Stationery Distribution to Needy Kids drive (Chopal Entrance near GT Road, Farah Village)**" where 24 participants took initiative. Through this initiative, the institute hopes to guide these destitute children towards independent and empowered lives, enabling them to make their own informed decisions. We believe that this will create a ripple effect, and the children and their parents will prioritize education. Its main purpose was to help underprivileged children to study.

There are a lot of children in the need of education. Eshan Club urged the volunteers to distribute stationery items so that the children move towards the path of education. According to our patron, through this drive, hoping to set in motion the educational journey of these underprivileged children. By providing them with access to educational supplies, we hope to create a foundation for independence and empowerment. Our children are like seeds. If nourished properly, we will have a progressive nation and a healthier society. The core team distributed 75 stationery kits to destitute children in Farah Village. Each kit contained: pens, pencils, sharpeners, erasers, sketchbooks, and crayons.

The stationery kit distribution acted as positive reinforcement and encouraged both children and their parents to take education seriously. At the end of the day, the main objective of this drive was to provide resources that otherwise would not be made available by the families of these children, because of their financial situation. Besides, we also provided drawing books and crayons in the same kit so that these children could experiment with colours. The children were really excited to receive stationery kits. Eshan started this positive change in their lives.
