Activity- "Voting Pledge Program"

Scheme- Lets Vote Social Awareness

Every person who is a citizen of India and who is not less than twenty-one years eighteen years of age on such date as may be fixed in that behalf by or under any law made by the appropriate Legislature and is not otherwise disqualified under this Constitution or any law made by the appropriate Legislature on the ground of non-residence, unsoundness of mind, crime or corrupt or illegal practice, shall be entitled to be registered as a voter at any such election. As part of this occasion, the "Voting Pledge Program" was administered by Students pledged to uphold democratic traditions of our country and the dignity of free, fair and peaceful elections without being influenced by considerations of religion, race, caste, community, language or any other inducement.

The pledge was undertaken to motivate young voters to exercise their privilege to cast a vote in free and fair elections in a free democratic country. Election pledges are made on important issues and on the policy themes emphasized most. Substantial differences in rates of pledge enactment can be found among majoritarian, coalition, and bicameral systems. Large number of 311 first time voters took pledge in favour of ethical voting in the district as part of the Election Commission of India's efforts. As desired by the Election Commission, our Director administered the pledge to the on campus to vote ethically upholding the democratic traditions of the country and the dignity of free, fair and peaceful elections.

Large number of students, especially, first-time voters were encouraged to take the pledge. The voters promised to vote honestly, fearlessly, without taking money and without being influenced by any undue inducement. "If I come to know of any malpractices, I shall bring it to the notice of electoral authorities for taking up corrective actions," the voters pledged. This was a very impressive effort by the college and it would surely prove to be inspirational for other institutes to follow such practices.
